If your going to leave lights on, consider placing them on timers, or ask a neighbor to turn them on and off for you.

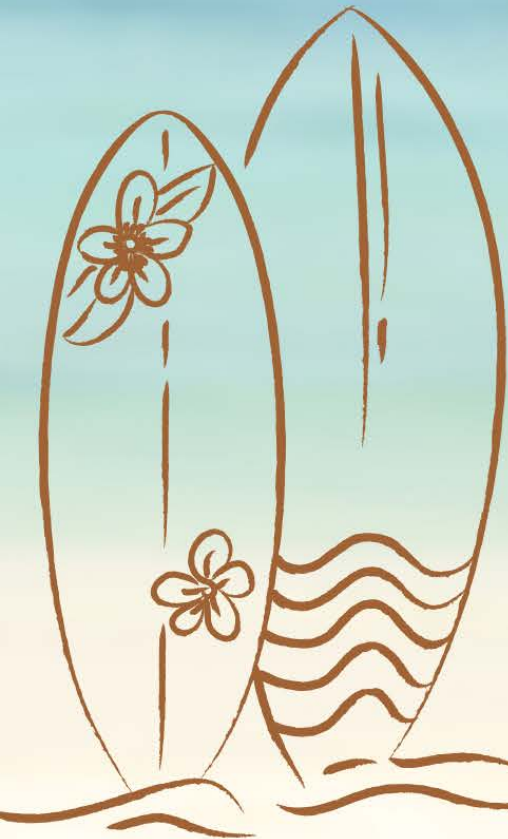
If you have a hard time keeping your house cool in the summer, it could mean it's time to replace your air filter or the insulation in your attic.

Lowering your water heater's temperature from 140F to 120F can reduce water heating cost.

Prevent air leaks by checking and repairing all cracked, separated or missing exterior caulking and weather stripping, especially around the windows and entry doors.

Request a vacation watch form the constables at Precinct 5 online at constablepct5.com, this lets the deputies who patrol your area know to keep an extra eye on things while you are away.

Precinct 5 recommends that you notify your alarm company to make their agency the first contact point when your alarm is triggered, even above yourself. This will save valuable time and get law enforcement en route immediately should your alarm go off.
